PSRU pays Courtesy visit to its counterpart in Ghana

Wednesday, 29th April 2026, Accra, Ghana: A high powered delegation from the Public Sector Reform Unit in Sierra Leone, paid a courtesy visit to its counterpart in Accra Ghana to strengthen collaboration and partnership.

Both the Public Sector Reform institutions of Sierra Leone and Ghana share similar mandates of strengthening governance systems and improving service delivery.
