Government Reaffirms Commitment to Public Sector Reform at Delivery Clinic



State House Freetown, 14th September, 2026: The Government of Sierra Leone has reaffirmed its commitment to strengthening public sector institutions, improving performance, and enhancing the delivery of quality public services to citizens.

The commitment was reaffirmed during a high-level Government Delivery Clinic convened by Chief Minister, Dr. David Moinina Sengh, where the Director of the Public Sector Reform Unit (PSRU) made a presentation on behalf of the Minister of Public

Administration and Political Affairs, Hon. Amara Kallon.

The presentation highlighted the sector's key achievements, ongoing challenges, and priorities for the 2026–2027 public-sector reform agenda under the Medium-Term National Development Plan (MTNDP). It also provided an opportunity to assess progress made in advancing reforms while identifying areas requiring greater attention and coordination.



The Delivery Clinic forms part of Government's efforts to strengthen implementation, monitoring, and accountability across priority areas of the national development agenda as it provides a platform for sectors to review performance, address implementation bottlenecks, and ensure that Government commitments translate into measurable results.

The engagement also underscored the interconnected nature of the public sector reform process with Management and Functional Reviews (MFRs) as a diagnostic tool for identifying institutional

weaknesses and recommending improvements in mandates, structures, systems, functions, and capacity.

A key outcome of the engagement was the Government’s reaffirmed commitment to supporting and advancing the public sector reform agenda, with continued collaboration among public-sector institutions and stakeholders identified as critical to achieving sustainable improvements.



Concluding the presentation Mr. Phoray-Musa further emphasized the need for stronger institutional coordination and sustained efforts to translate reform initiatives into improved efficiency, performance, and service delivery.
