PSRU Convenes Technical Retreat to Consolidate Draft Management and Functional Review Report for the Ministry of Technical and Higher Education and its Sectors



Companero, Bureh Peninsula, Friday, 25 September 2026 – The Public Sector Reform Unit (PSRU) has convened a technical retreat bringing together technical staff and stakeholders to facilitate the development and consolidation of the draft Management and Functional Review (MFR) Report for the Higher Education Sector.

The technical retreat brings together technical personnel from the Public Sector Reform Unit (PSRU), the Institute of Public Administration and Management (IPAM), and Fourah Bay College (FBC), to collaboratively review and consolidate the outcomes of the MFR exercise.

The exercise which stems from a cabinet conclusion is focused on consolidating findings from field studies and data collection, collating research materials, and incorporating inputs from stakeholders to ensure that the draft report presents a comprehensive assessment of the Higher Education Sector.

Through this collaborative process, participants are expected to examine the data gathered during the review, harmonise research findings, and contribute to the development of a consolidated report that reflects the operational realities, challenges, and priorities of the sector.
